- 6. Allow compound to dry thoroughly (approximately 3 hours, depending on temperature, humidity and depth of fill) before reapplying or painting with latex or oil-based paints. Follow paint manufacturer's recommendations regarding priming and application.
- 7. **DO NOT USE AS A SKIM COAT.** For exterior applications always apply topcoat with a high quality exterior grade paint when fully cured and prior to water exposure.
