It develops a strong, durable and permanent bond to landscape blocks, synthetic stone, wood, concrete, treated wood and other hardscape materials. Use for permanent, structural installation of retaining walls, garden walls and water feature perimeters.

Surface Preparation & Application:

SAFETY FIRST! PRODUCT IS EXTREMELY FLAMMABLE WHEN DISPENSING. Before using, read & understand all health & safety information/product use instructions found below.

INSTRUCTIONS:

- 1. Never leave applicator gun without completely shutting off its control knob.
- 2. Keep fingers off the trigger until ready to apply.
- 3. Never point the nozzle at yourself or others.
- 4. Always assume applicator gun is pressurized.
- 5. Make sure applicator gun's control knob is shut off before you begin working.
- 6. Surface must be clean, dry and free of dirt, dust and other contamination.
- 7. Always wear safety glasses, gloves & protective clothing during use.
- 8. Shake can well before using & intermittently during use.
- 9. Attach adhesive applicator gun on to canister. Do not over tighten. Ensure threads are aligned to prevent leakage.
- 10. Slowly adjust and set control knob to for desired flow.
- 11. Slowly pull trigger to release foam.
- 12. Apply a continuous bead to substrate, with nozzle slightly above work surface. Product works best on horizontal surfaces. Not for overhead use. Clamping or bracing may be needed.
- 13. Within 8 minutes, position & press substrates firmly into place.
- 14. Shake can intermittently while dispensing.
- 15. Full cure in 24 hours.

Storage: Store gun attached to partially used foam canister for up to one month. If longer storage is required, remove applicator from canister and clean as directed. Shelf life of DAP® SMARTBONDTM Landscape Construction Adhesive once applicator is removed from adhesive canister is greatly diminished. It is not recommended to store partially used canisters without the applicator attached.

For Best Results:

- Test trigger pull tension on scrap material
- To speed cure in low humidity, lightly mist joists with water before application.
- Product spreads and slightly expands. Whenever possible, keep bead 1" away from edge of decorative edge of blocks.
- Not for continuous water submersion.
- If using on concrete, allow concrete to cure fully (at least 28 days).
- Apply in temperatures 23°F to 105°F.
- Store above 60°F. Product will gun slowly when cold.

Clean-up and Removal: Clean gun by removing the foam canister and replacing it with a can of DAP® SMARTBONDTM Adhesive Cleaner. Shake canister and discharge into a trash receptacle. Repeat 3 or 4 times or until discharge is clear and free of adhesive residue. Remove canister of DAP® SMARTBONDTM Adhesive Cleaner and tighten down control valve on gun for storage. The cleaner can also be used to clean up wet foam spills and tools. Test surfaces to ensure surface is compatible with cleaner before cleaning. Do not use DAP® SMARTBONDTM Adhesive Cleaner to clean skin.
